Phase two of the building will turn it into a proper theatre building again. The blue velvet seats have returned to Oban to be stored by Argyll Removals and Storage until they can once again be brought to Mull, and the tradition of professional theatre on Mull is resumed once again.

As well as building a new production centre, Mull Theatre has also been expanding in other ways. This month it welcomes Alasdair Satchel as a full-time Drama and Education Officer. Alasdair, who is from Dunoon, will be based on Mull and working all over Argyll. He is the closure leader for Argyll College's HNC in Acting and Performance, run in conjunction with Mull Theatre.
