

Dance band debut for new studio

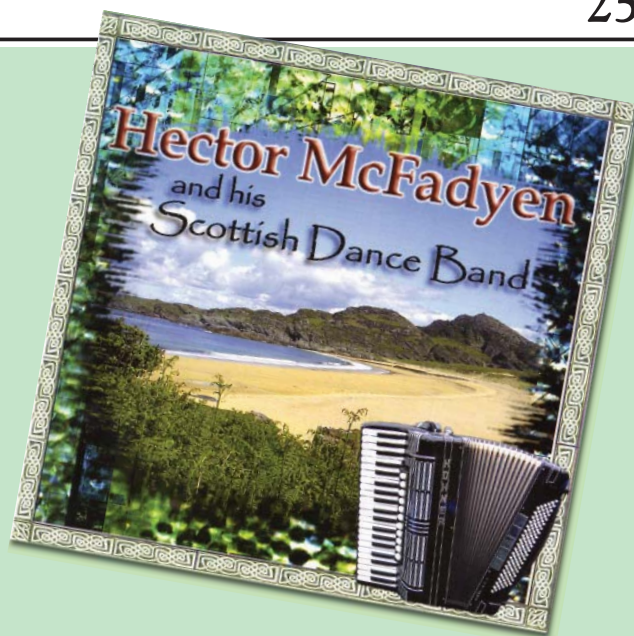
The first album to come from Oban's new recording studio features the sound of Hector McFadyen and his Scottish Dance band.
