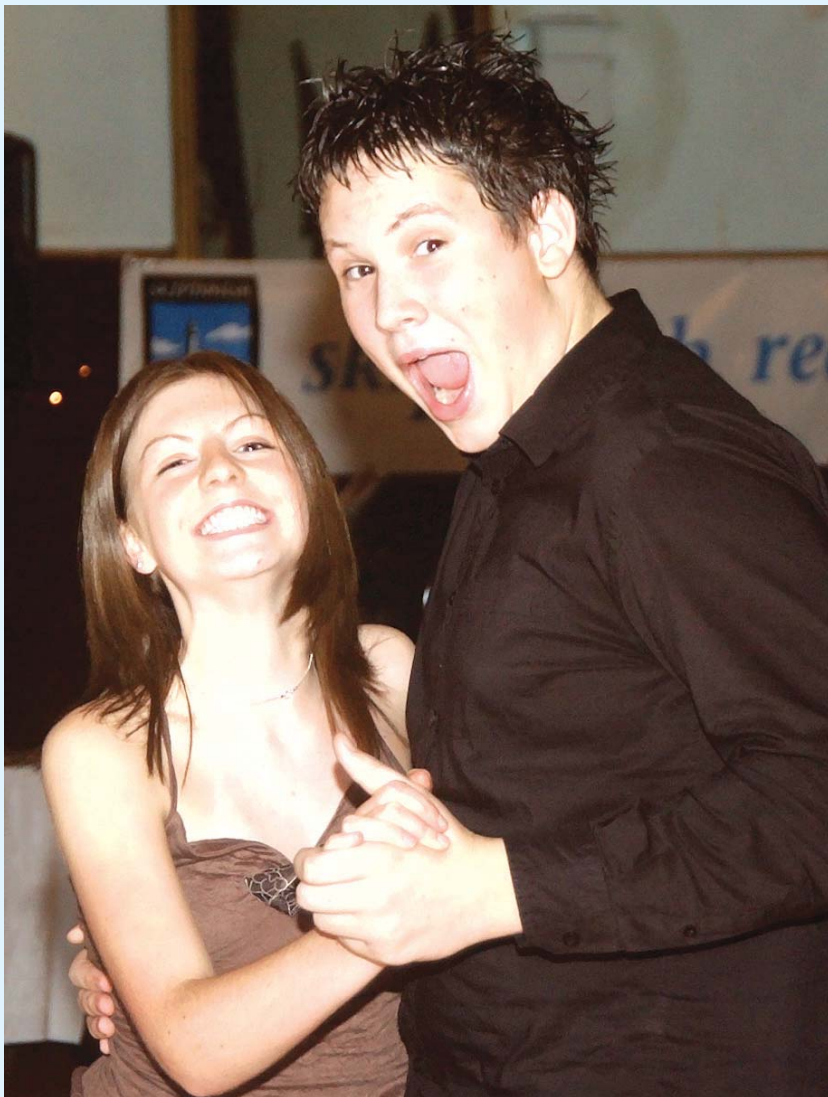


# Life through the lens
