## Celebrating a Scouting centenary

TWO LORN Scouts will take part in the most important gathering of international Scouts in 100 years.

Ardchattan Scouts John Cameron, aged 14, from Dunbeg and Alistair Hoon, aged 13, from North Connel will be among the group representing Scotland at the Centenary World Jamboree which takes place at the same venue as the first ever Jamboree in Hylands Park, Cheltenham.

John and Alistair, who have been in the Scouts for seven and eight years respectively, will attend the Jamboree between July 27 and August 8 next year, providing they can raise £1,000 each.

As *Lorn Life* went to press, the boys had raised just over £1,000 altogether and were looking for dona-

tions to help them reach the total of £2,000.

John said: 'Argyll was allocated two places and we snatched up one straight away but when we heard Oban were not applying for a place, we got the second as well.'

'We were really pleased that we both got to go and it feels really good to be part of it.'

Alistair added: 'We are really lucky to get a place and I am pleased and excited.'

The boys have been helped by an open day at Ardchattan Priory where there were games and activities. Proceeds from the open day, coupled with donations already pledged have given the Scouts their total of £1,000 but they are appealing for people to donate money at their bag pack in November and forthcoming coffee morning.
